Project name: Beaded Beads

Techniques used: Various

Beads used: Seed beads sizes 08/0 and 11/0, 4 mm—6 mm fire-polished beads, glass pearls or crystals

Description: Almost every beader is once in a while faced with the problem of finding “the right bead in the right colour(s)” for a certain project. One solution for the problem is: Make your own beads.

There are instructions for three different beaded beads in this tutorial. These beads are fun and easy to make and do not require special beading knowledge, although having encountered Right Angle Weave before does give you an advantage.

Project name: Crystal Butterfly Pendant

Techniques used: Cross Weave, Wirework

Beads used: Seed beads size 11/0, 4 mm & 6 mm Swarovski crystals, Rhinestone rondelles, Crystal drops and 4 mm fire-polished beads

Description: This pendant is easy and fun to make. Using different crystals, fire-polished beads and/or glass pearls, you can easily change the look of your butterfly. Use as pendant, charm or attach to a brooch pin!

Techniques used: Flat Peyote Stitch, Fringing

Beads used: Seed beads sizes 11/0 and 15/0,
4 mm Swarovski crystals

Project name: Bezelled Stone Cabochons

Techniques used: Right Angle Weave,
Net Weave

Beads used: Stone Cabochons, Seed beads
in sizes 11/0 and 15/0

Description: Various stitches are combined to create this bezel for a cabochon. These beaded cabochons can be used as pendants, brooches, focal beads, etc.

Knowledge of Right Angle Weave is essential for this project!

Project name: Basic Russian Leaves

Techniques used: Flat Peyote Stitch

Beads used: Seed beads in size 08/0, 11/0 or 15/0

Description: There are various methods to create “Russian Leaves”. The common denominator in stitching the leaves seems to be Flat Peyote Stitch. Use Russian Leaves for earrings, brooches, bracelets or necklaces.

Knowledge of Flat Peyote Stitch is essential for this project!

Project name: Veined Russian Leaves

Techniques used: Flat Peyote Stitch

Beads used: Seed beads in sizes 11/0 & 15/0

Description: This is a more elaborate form of “Russian Leaves”. Use the leaves as embellishments for earrings, brooches, bracelets or necklaces.

Knowledge of Flat Peyote Stitch is essential for this project!

Project name: Crystal Heart or Pearl Heart

Techniques used: Right Angle Weave

Beads used: 44 4 mm Swarovski crystals or
4 mm glass pearls

Description: Made as a gift or for yourself, worked in crystals or glass pearls—this heart is a winner!

Knowledge of Right Angle Weave is helpful when attempting this project!

Project name: Heart Charms

Techniques used: Tubular Peyote

Beads used: Japanese cylinder beads 11/0
(Delicas) and 15/0 Japanese seed beads

Description: Versatile heart charms, that can be used singly or joined with Peyote bands. Make lovely pendants for necklaces or charm bracelets, sun-catchers or key rings or cell-phone charms.
Dimensions: 28 mm x 32 mm

The kit includes materials to make 2 heart charms OR one heart charm and matching strung necklace. Please state your preference as well as colour preference(s) when booking for this project.

Knowledge of Tubular Peyote Stitch is necessary for this project!

Project level: Intermediate

Project name: Rivoli Pendant

Techniques used: Peyote Stitch

Beads used: 14 mm Rivoli, 4 mm glass pearls, 4 mm Swarovski crystals, seed beads in sizes 11/0 and 15/0, Czech Charlottes

Description: Peyote Stitch is used to work a bezel for a Rivoli crystal, which is then embellished. These Rivolis can be used in bracelet, earrings, rings, brooches, or - with a bail attached - as pendants. The kit contains materials to make a Rivoli pendant with all embellishments shown above right. It is up to you how far to take the embellishment.

Knowledge of Peyote Stitch is essential for this project!

Project level: Beginner

Project name: Netted Flowers

Techniques used: Net Weave

Beads used: Size 11/0 seed beads and 4 mm glass pearl

Description: These beautiful flowers can be used to adorn brooches, pendants, as focal points of a daisy chain bracelet, stitched onto hat bands, etc. Have fun and experiment with beads of different colours and shapes!

The kit contains materials to make at least 2 flowers!

Project name: Angel Charms

Techniques used: Brick Stitch, Fringing

Beads used: Japanese cylinder beads 11/0 (Delicas), 15/0 Japanese seed beads and 4 mm Swarovski bicone crystals for the fringe

Description: These lovely “Guardian Angels” are ideal as small gifts or gift tags, handbag- or cell phone charms. Height of angels (head to fringe): 40 mm

As the beads are rather small, knowledge of Brick Stitch - including increases and decreases - is necessary for this project!
