Project name: Beaded Flower Miniatures

Techniques used: Wirework

Beads used: Size 11/0 seed beads

Description: These charming low-maintenance flowers look lovely in a rosebud-vase or can be used to adorn brooches, hats, lapels, gifts, etc.

You can also “plant” them into a decorative miniature flower pot!

Kit contains all the materials to make all four different flowers shown in the photo above (Rose, Iris, Daffodil and Tulip).

Project name: Peyote Easter Egg Cover

Techniques used: 2-drop Peyote Stitch,
Net Weave (Netting)

Beads used: Seed beads sizes 11/0 and 08/0,
6 mm glass pearl

Description: A somewhat different Easter Egg! A delightful ornament as well as a welcome gift at Easter time.

The kit contains 1 hen-egg sized wooden egg and all the materials for the embellishment.

Knowledge of Peyote Stitch essential when attempting this project!

Project name: Flower Medallion Easter Egg

Techniques used: Net Weave (Netting),
Daisy Chain Stitch

Beads used: Seed beads sizes 11/0, 6 mm
bugle beads and 6 mm glass pearls or fire-
polished beads

Description: Spectacular in a floral way! Not for the “beader in a hurry”, as the embellishments are rather time-consuming.

The kit contains 1 hen-egg sized wooden egg and all the materials for the embellishment.

Knowledge of Netting and Daisy-Chain Stitch essential when attempting this project!

Project name: “Nasturtiums” Easter Egg

Techniques used: Flat and Tubular Peyote
Stitch, Net Weave (Netting)

Beads used: Japanese cylinder beads
(Delicas) and 15/0 Japanese seed beads

Description: Inspired by a hand-painted, Russian, wooden egg. A real heirloom!

The kit contains 1 hen-egg sized wooden egg and all the materials for the embellishment.

Knowledge of Peyote Stitch essential when attempting this project!
